3. Use the username and password provided by your child's teacher to log in. You can use the same login details to access all four Doodle programmes.

## New Growing Up and Moving On Service

**Engagement session for parent carers of children and young people with SEND.**

In order to try to improve the transition process into adult services, a new service called the Growing Up and Moving On Service will be established to work with people aged 18-25 who are eligible for support from Wiltshire Council social care.

As part of the development of GUMOS, Wiltshire Council is undertaking to engage with parent carers to explore and discuss the proposal in partnership with Wiltshire Parent Carer Council and Carer Support Wiltshire.

**Three daytime face-to-face sessions and an evening virtual/online session will be held.**

There will also be an online consultation page hosted by Wiltshire Council.
