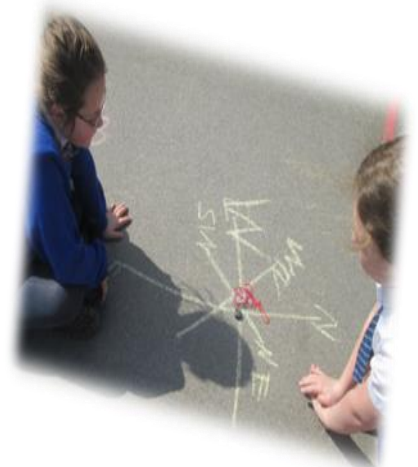
Hello everyone,

Doodle builds confidence and ability in maths and English by creating every child a personalised work programme tailored to their strengths and weaknesses. Using Doodle for just 10 minutes a day is proven to help children make three months of progress in just one month!

How to get started

2. Download all of the Doodle apps (DoodleMaths, DoodleTables, DoodleEnglish and DoodleSpell) onto an Apple, Android or Amazon device. You can also log in to the Doodle programmes through the website (doodlelearning.com) on laptops and desktops by clicking 'log in' and choosing a programme. Follow the instructions in the video above to log in.
3. Use the username and password provided by your child's teacher to log in. You can use the same login details to access all four Doodle programmes.

Support for parents and carers

- Link your email address to your child's account by logging in, tapping on the arrow icon in the top left-hand corner and selecting Settings > Parent details.
Or, visit parents.doodlelearning.com and head to Manage > Subscriptions.
- You'll then be able to view your child's progress by visiting parents.doodlelearning.com or downloading the free DoodleConnect app on Apple and Android devices.

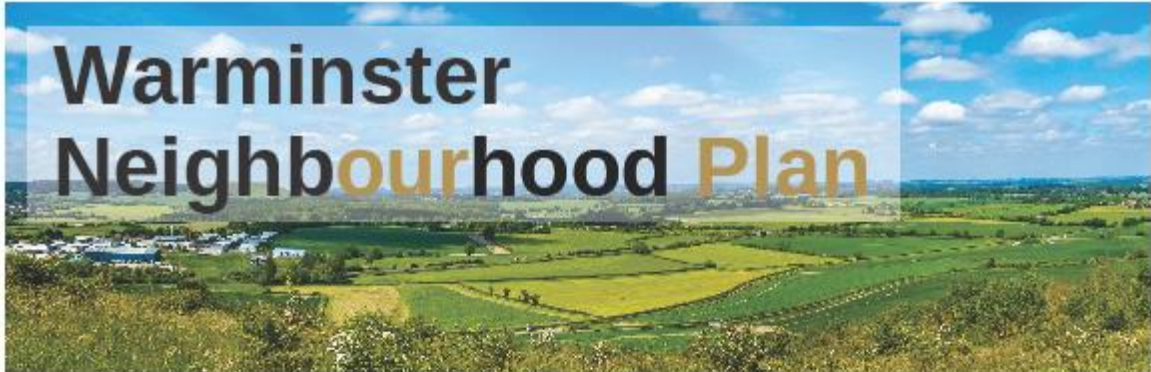
