Place Value

Partitioning three digit numbers.

Understanding the value of each digit in a 3-digit number.

Finding 1, 10 and 100 more and less than a 3-digit number.

Addition and Subtraction

Adding 3-digit and 1-digit numbers and adding two 3-digit numbers.

Subtracting 2-digit numbers from 3-digit numbers and 3-digit numbers from 3-digit numbers.

Multiplication and Division

Multiplying and dividing by 3, 4 and 8 and learning these times tables.

Rocks and Soils

Handling and examining rocks to identify their properties.

Understanding how soil is formed.

Making careful observations and using scientific language.

Exploring magnets and carrying out investigations.

Finding out about different forces and carrying out friction investigations.

Using a range of different sources to find out about the Stone Age.

Researching Stone Age food, inventions, farming and homes.

Using timelines to place the Stone Age and ordering important events in the Stone Age.

Asking and answering their own question about the Stone Age.

Looking at how Britain has changes since the Stone Age.
